Meet JHIE Users

Douglas County Clinicians Now Experiencing Benefits of JHIE

Following the expansion to the Columbia Gorge region earlier this year, JHIE is now bringing its <u>Community Health Record</u> to Douglas County.

By offering providers the ability to search, view and download their patients' clinical results, labs and patient summaries, known as CCDs, patient care in these communities will become more efficient and effective.

Dr. Christine Seals, a sole practitioner located in Roseburg, makes referrals primarily to Eugene and Medford, and uses JHIE to coordinate care, noting that having an HIE in one of the two major places where she refers is a huge deal.

"One patient who lives in an outlying area has COPD, is frequently hospitalized and has frequent ER visits but does not have a physician nearby. I use JHIE to manage her medications and treatment from a distance," she said.

Seals is just starting to use JHIE and sees huge potential, particularly with integrating behavioral health so providers can have a better understanding of the patient's history and needs. She also sees the value of having practices in more regions join.

"The more facilities that use the system, the better it is because with more facilities you have more information," she said.

She noted that the recent tragedy at Umpqua Community College highlights HIE's value. She has been treating patients at various locations, and the only way she can communicate with the other providers is by fax and phone.

"I kept thinking wouldn't it have been great if we had the records in JHIE, because when there is a disaster messages can get lost. What we did worked, but JHIE could streamline things so you can communicate with the specific doctor you want to reach. JHIE ensures checks and balances and has trackable systems," she said.

Kim Tyree, chief operations officer of Evergreen Family Medicine in Roseburg, also sees the value JHIE provides to the community.

"The benefit of using JHIE is the ability for the providers to make informed decisions in real time." She also noted that having the ability to view patient information helps provide more complete information leading to better care, as many of Evergreen's patients are elderly and do not always remember what procedures they may have had or medications other providers have subscribed.

Tyree had worked with JHIE previously at Klamath Open Door Family Practice, and her experience led Evergreen to join JHIE.

"When we pioneered the venture in Klamath Falls, the hospital was also part of the solution and interfaced with JHIE and Klamath Open Door to get patient information in real time. We are not there yet in Roseburg, but are having those conversations with the hospital and the CCO," she said.

Since its inception in early 2013, JHIE has built and demonstrated success as a sustainable, actively growing HIE, first operating among Jackson, Josephine and Klamath Counties in Southern Oregon, next expanding north to the Gorge Region and now operating in Douglas County. To date, JHIE has enrolled more than 674 physicians, behavioral health providers, dentists, physical therapists, home health, hospice and other providers in 183 care settings.

Currently Evergreen Family Medicine uses JHIE to track patients who see specialists in Southern Oregon. Tyree hopes to gain access to patient information from the entire community and state so that Evergreen can provide more efficient care. She also believes patients will benefit by receiving services, referrals, and procedures in a more streamlined fashion and by having their providers receive their test results faster.

As more practices and health care systems join JHIE, the Community Health Record will become more robust and provide more clinical information to providers, resulting in greater efficiencies and better care for patients.

"I would absolutely encourage (and have encouraged) other providers in Douglas County to join JHIE. It is an obvious choice for those clinics that truly understand the benefit of full scope patient centered care." Tyree noted.

JHIE to Expand Services through Federal Grant

JHIE users and their patients will benefit from expanded and enhanced services over the next two years, with support from federal grant funds awarded to the Oregon Health Authority and JHIE.

In July 2015 the federal Office of the National Coordinator for Health Information Technology (ONC) awarded \$1.6 million to OHA and JHIE. The funds will be used to expand JHIE services to overcome barriers to information sharing and care coordination across care settings and integrate behavioral and physical health data for more robust health information exchange.

As a result of this work, participating providers will soon be able to:

Provide better care with the inclusion of authorized behavioral health (BH) data.

JHIE users will be able to search and view patients' records that reflect BH data including mental health, and alcohol/drug treatment information, along with physical health data. The integration of behavioral and physical health data will improve care coordination and provide JHIE users with a more complete picture of their patients' health.

Exchange data with the Veterans Administration (VA) and Social Security Administration (SSA).

JHIE will become nationally certified to enable JHIE users to exchange data with the VA, allowing providers treating patients who cross both systems to have access to clinical information and treatment decisions made by other providers. JHIE users also will be able to respond to SSA determination inquires through JHIE to speed up benefits determinations, ensuring patients receive timely and comprehensive care.

Receive real-time emergency department (ED) notifications.

Participating providers will know when their patients present at EDs throughout Oregon as a result of a collaboration between JHIE and the Emergency Department Information Exchange (EDIE) program. JHIE providers will know if their patients visited any Oregon ED or were admitted to a hospital out of their region. Additionally, through a notification application, JHIE users will be able to upload a list of patients or members for which to be notified of hospital or clinical events important to their treatment plan. Notifications can be configured to fit into the user's workflow and the user can decide what notifications they want and when. Users can then access patient clinical data securely through JHIE to improve care coordination, reduce readmissions, ensure post-discharge follow up, direct patients to more appropriate care settings and support value-based care.

Receive technical assistance for workflow redesign. JHIE users will have the opportunity to receive assistance to learn how to maximize the benefits of their EHRs and the JHIE Community Health Record, promoting workflow efficiencies, meaningful use and better experiences for providers and patients.

As a health information exchange, we aim to have all hospitals, clinics and health care providers in the region exchanging information in a secure and standardized manner. Our mission is to facilitate patient-centered care through a community-driven and provider-led collaboration that promotes better health and provides value through secure and trusted patient information sharing.

Hospitals, independent physician associations (IPA), clinics, and Continuous Care Organizations (CCO) participate in the JHIE, which is growing rapidly in enrollment and adoption.

JHIE Expands Services for Users in the Columbia Gorge

Mid-Columbia Medical Center is Now Contributing Data to JHIE; JHIE Community Health Record Enrollment is Now Open

During the summer, Mid-Columbia Medical Center in The Dalles began contributing clinical data to the JHIE Community Health Record. Mid-Columbia Medical Center is providing real-time lab results, radiology reports and links to images, transcribed reports and admission/discharge face sheets to JHIE. JHIE is now taking enrollments for JHIE iNexx users in the Gorge so they can query the JHIE Community Health Record and receive clinical results from the Gorge and all of the JHIE contributing hospitals, including Providence Hood River Memorial Hospital (coming in 2016) directly into a connected EHR or web-based clinical inbox.

Mid-Columbia joins our other data contributing health systems (Asante Health Systems and Sky Lakes Medical Center) along with ambulatory clinics (Klamath Open Door, Medford Medical Clinic and Southern Oregon Cardiology), and the list is growing.
